A vacancy exists for a Bench Repair Technician in Cape Town.

To provide technical expertise by repairing spares and tracking repairs, taking parts for quality assurance and complying with occupational health and safety requirements to ensure that there are sufficient parts available to be sent to field services and that they are of an acceptable quality.

The responsibilities of the position include:

Repairing Spares and Tracking Repairs

- Collecting parts to be repaired from the faulty parts stores, depending on which spares the supervisor or team leader have scheduled to be repaired, as team members can be rotated to repair different spares according to priority spares
- Scanning in the part that is being worked on when starting to repair the part
- Diagnosing what is wrong with the part and obtaining the appropriate small spares required from the small spares store in order to fix the spares

Occupational health and safety

- Ensuring that the work station is kept neat at all times to avoid any accidentals or injuries
- Inspecting tools to ensure that they are in proper working order
- Reporting any damage to tools or unsafe working environmental issues or practices to the team leader, supervisor or safety representative

In order to be considered for the position, the following requirements must be met:

- Matric
- Introductory/Basic electrical and mechanical Course (FET College) would be an advantage
- MS Office
- 1 year in electrical or mechanical repairs technical experience
- Ideally this candidate should have knowledge of ATM spares
